### **One Minutes** (10 per side)

**H.Res. 982** - Provides for adoption of H. Res. 979 - Recommending that the House of Representatives find Harriet Miers and Joshua Bolten, Chief of Staff, White House, in contempt of Congress for refusal to comply with subpoenas duly issued by the Committee on the Judiciary, and provides for adoption of H. Res. 980 - Authorizing the Committee on the Judiciary to initiate or intervene in judicial proceedings to enforce certain subpoenas (*Sponsored by Rep. Slaughter / Rules Committee*)

### **Possible consideration of Legislation Regarding the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act**

- 1) **H.Res. 966** - Honoring African American inventors, past and present, for their leadership, courage, and significant contributions to our national competitiveness (*Sponsored by Rep. Eddie Bernice Johnson / Science and Technology Committee*)

- 3) **S. 2571** - To make technical corrections to the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (*Sponsored by Sen. Harkin / Agriculture Committee*)
- 4) **H.Con.Res. 289** - Honoring and praising the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People on the occasion of its 99th anniversary (*Sponsored by Rep. Al Green / Judiciary Committee*)
- 5) **H.R. 4169** - American Braille Flag Memorial Act (*Sponsored by Rep. Tiahrt / Veterans' Affairs Committee*)
- 6) **H.Res. 790** - Commending the people of the State of Washington for showing their support for the needs of the State of Washington's veterans and encouraging residents of other States to pursue creative ways to show their own support for veterans (*Sponsored by Rep. Baird / Veterans' Affairs Committee*)
- 7) **H.Res. 963** - Supporting the goals and ideals of National Salute to Hospitalized Veterans Week, and for other purposes. (*Sponsored by Rep. Rodriguez / Veterans' Affairs Committee*)
- 8) **H.Res. 972** - Supporting the Goals and Ideals of American Heart Month and National Wear Red Day (*Sponsored by Rep. Capps / Energy and Commerce Committee*)
